

TRANSITION TO FOURTH YEAR CHECK LIST

FEBRUARY 2019

- Fourth Year Orientation
- Access VSLO Application Service (Fourth Year Coordinator will provide access)

MARCH 2019

- Request MSPE at the Registrar’s Office
- March 30th - Submit MSPE Questionnaire
- Complete FAFSA

APRIL 2019

- April 15th - Complete VSLO Applicant Profile. Registrar’s Office cannot verify a student whose application has not been completed. Take into consideration that there may be a fee for some rotations.
- April 16th - FAFSA Deadline
- April 30th – Complete Clinical Clerkship Petition Form also known as “Wish List”

MAY 2019

- Follow up on Noteworthy Characteristics, Community Activities and Research
- Attend ERAS Orientation Workshop and begin ERAS application process

JUNE 2019

- June – Complete 3rd year rotations. Any Incomplete affects the MSPE of **ALL** students. Please remove on a timely manner.
- Start requesting Letters of Recommendations (LoRs)

JULY 2019

- Request Transcript ERAS
- Follow up on ERAS application

AUGUST 2019

- Follow up on ERAS application
- Finish requesting LoRs
- Review MSPE draft

SEPTEMBER 2019

- Complete ERAS application by Sept. 15th. Applications may be submitted during the entire ERAS season, but depending on the programs deadline, doing so may affect your possibilities
- Sept. 15th – ERAS opens for application submission
- Sept. 15th - Register for the National Resident Matching Program (NRMP) Main Residency Match

OCTOBER 2019

- Oct. 1st – ERAS releases MSPE’s to residency programs

NOVEMBER 2019 TO JANUARY 2020

- Interview Season
- Nov 30th Deadline to register for NRMP without penalty
- Mid Dec Deadline for San Francisco Match (Urology and/or Ophthalmology) registration
- Dec –Results Military Match released

JANUARY 2020

- Verify graduation requirements
- Order graduation gown and white coat

FEBRUARY 2020

- Feb 25th – Deadline for certifying Ranking Order List (ROL) for The Match (NRMP) Residency programs applied to. **Must have passing score in Step 2 CK and CS.** Be sure to program early in the year

MARCH 2020

- March 16 –NRMP results released
- March 16-20 – SOAP (Supplemental Offer and Acceptance Program)
- March 20th – Match Day Ceremony
- Complete Exit Counseling with Financial Aid Office

APRIL 2020

- Request graduation with Registrar
- Fill out AAMC GQ Questionnaire

MAY 2020

- Complete all graduation requirements
- Pick up graduation gown and white coat
- Pick up invitation for Commencement ceremony

JUNE 2020

- Graduation
